





KRISHNA SANGAM 3, the 1<sup>st</sup> interstate dental convention which was held from 11<sup>th</sup>-13<sup>th</sup> March 2016, themed with "Road Map to Dental Research" indeed was a grand success. The convention was an amalgamation of academics, sports and cultural events giving a great opportunity to all the students to portray their immense knowledge and talent. This was a platform that truly showed us that the students are extremely talented at par in academic, sports, and extra-curricular activities. Our guest delegates were the talented students from KLE Dental College and Aditya Dental College, Beed. A total of 500 delegates attended the conference. The registration counter was arranged outside the Annexure building, KIMSDU. The breakfast was served to all the delegates in the nursing college.

On the **first day**, convention started with inaugural function dated 11<sup>th</sup> march 2016 at 10.30am in Jupiter hall (Annexure building, KIMSDU). 




#### **YUVANA 2017:**


#### Objective/purpose:

#### Dental Premiere League Report - Box Cricket 2017



#### Day 4:8th February 2018: Retro Day


