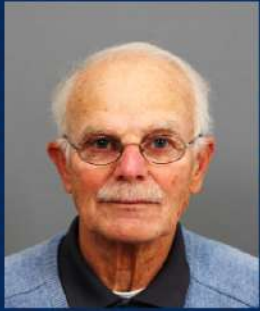

Rules For Abstract Submission

- Registration is compulsory to submit abstracts.
- Abstracts can be original research, case series, case report or systematic review.
- The presentation should not have been previously presented elsewhere or published in a journal.
- Only one author per presentation is allowed.
- All the abstracts submitted by postgraduate students must be authorized and countersigned by the Head of Departments.
- All abstracts must be submitted through email to email id: symposium.omfs@gmail.com
- Only abstracts submitted within the specified deadline - **25th October 2020, before 05:00 PM**, will be considered for audio visual presentation by scientific committee.
- Plagiarism is strictly prohibited and the presenter will be disqualified if found guilty of plagiarism.

Abstract Format

- **Language:** English, Font Size - 12, Font Type - Times New Roman, Spacing - Single line
- **Title:** Title should be as brief as possible and typed in sentence case (all letters in lowercase except the first letter of each word)
- **Author:** Affiliation details of author, department, institution/hospital, city/town, state (if relevant) and country should be included.
- **Abstract text word limit:** Not more than 250 words. (Title & author's details are excluded)
- **For original research:** Introduction, objectives, study design, methodology, results and conclusions
- **For case report:** Introduction, case report, clinical significance
- **For meta analysis and systematic review:** Introduction, results and conclusion
- **Abstracts along with audio-visual presentation should be submitted to the email id: symposium.omfs@gmail.com**

Audio Visual Presentation Guidelines



- Participants should send audio visual recording of their presentation along with the abstract at symposium.omfs@gmail.com.
- Presentation should be on Microsoft Power Point 2007 or later.
- Presenters should strictly adhere to the allotted time of 8 minutes.
- Only one person can be a presenter.
- The identity of the author/presenter, department and institutional background should not be revealed. Any attempt to reveal identity will attract disqualification from the competitive category.
- The decision of the scientific team will be final and binding.
