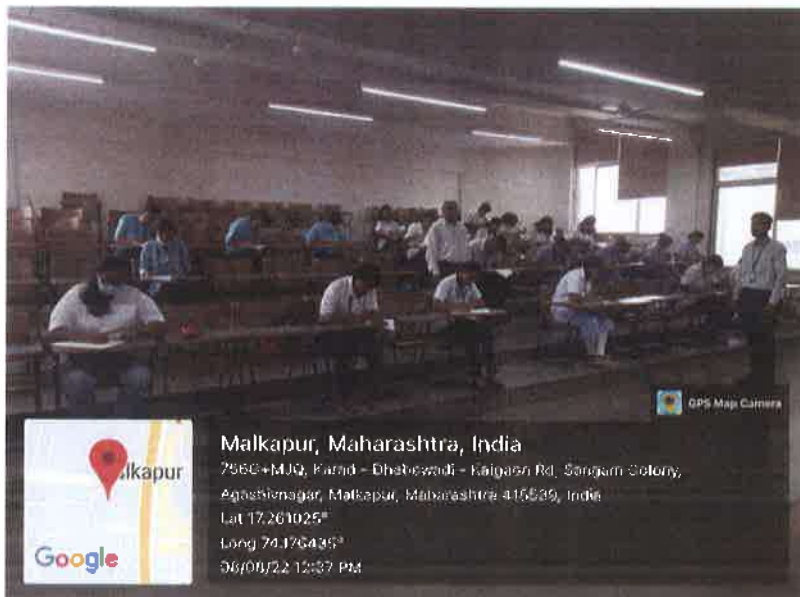

All Higher Education Institutions/INIs are requested to organize "Bharatiya Bhasha Utsav" on 11th December 2022 in a grand manner and promote the "Language Harmony" among the Students and Youth of the Society to nurture rich cultural oneness of our nation. The scale of the festival/Utsav may be different depending on the level of celebration and participation. The festival may be organised as a part


