

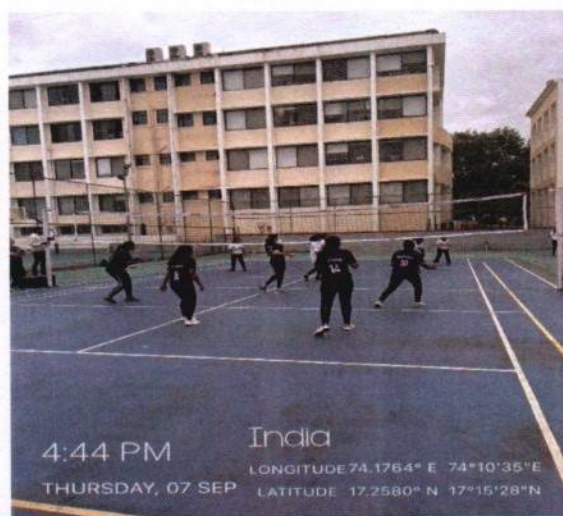


Day-5 :- Moonlight mirage day (THE MOON LIGHT MIRAGE)

In conclusion, the Moon light mirage celebration was a resounding success, leaving participants with lasting memories.

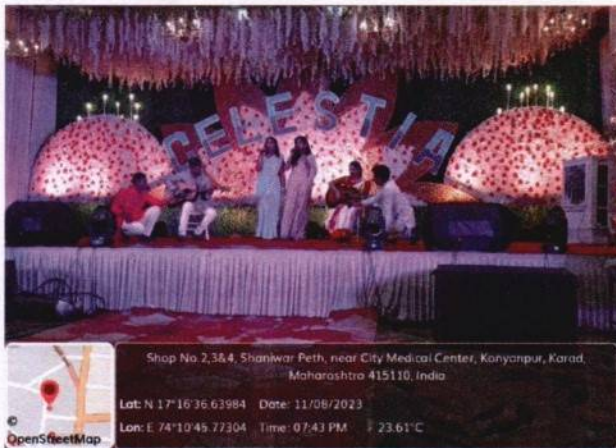

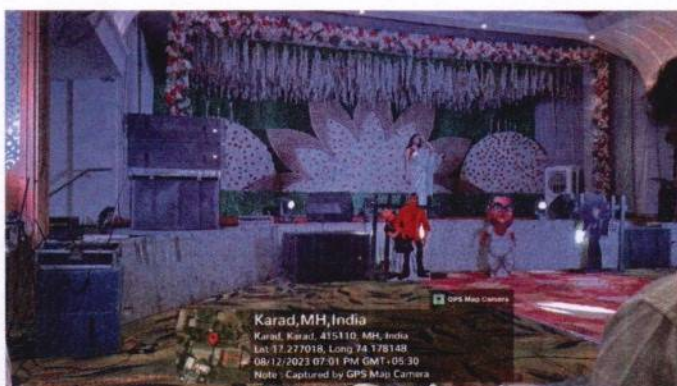

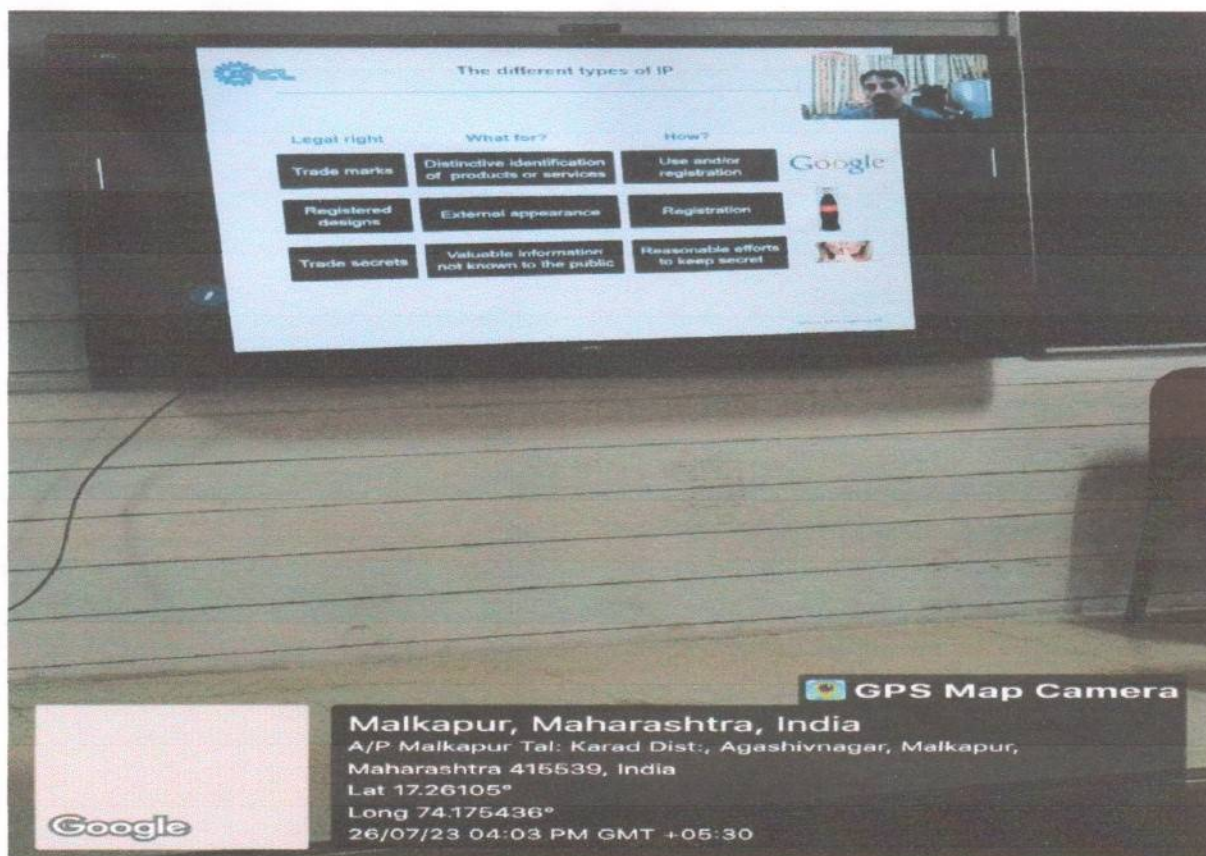
Programme Summary:

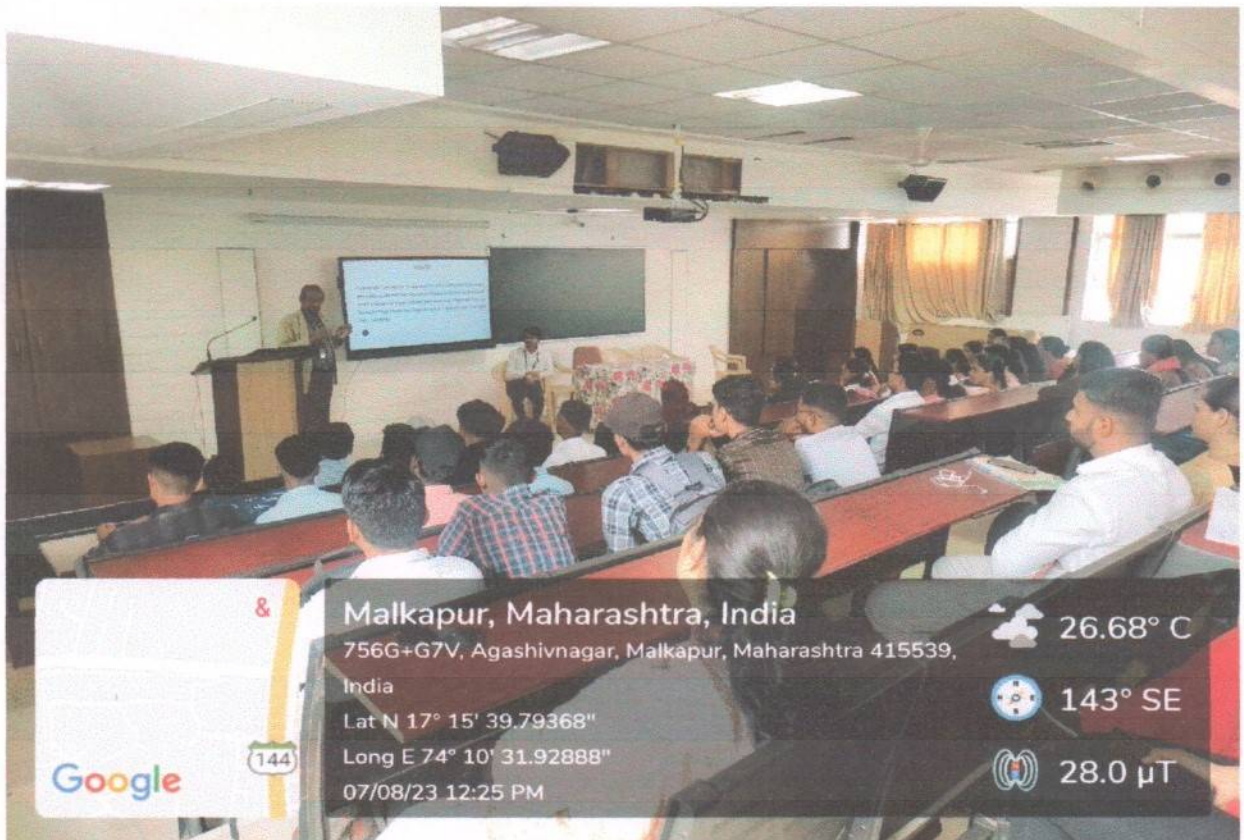
The students were taken to the round accompanied by some faculty members & PhD research scholars on the campus of the University to make them aware of the locations of

Action Taken Report on “Meri Maati Mera Desh Campaign”

Background of the campaign:

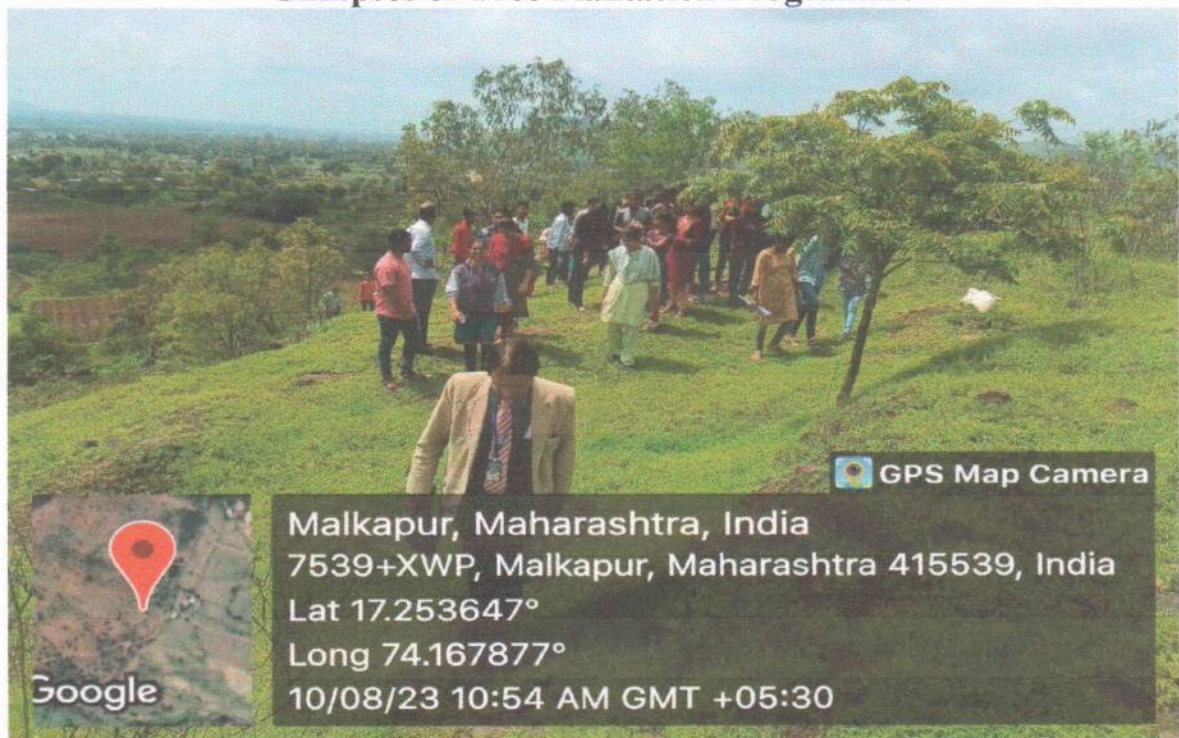

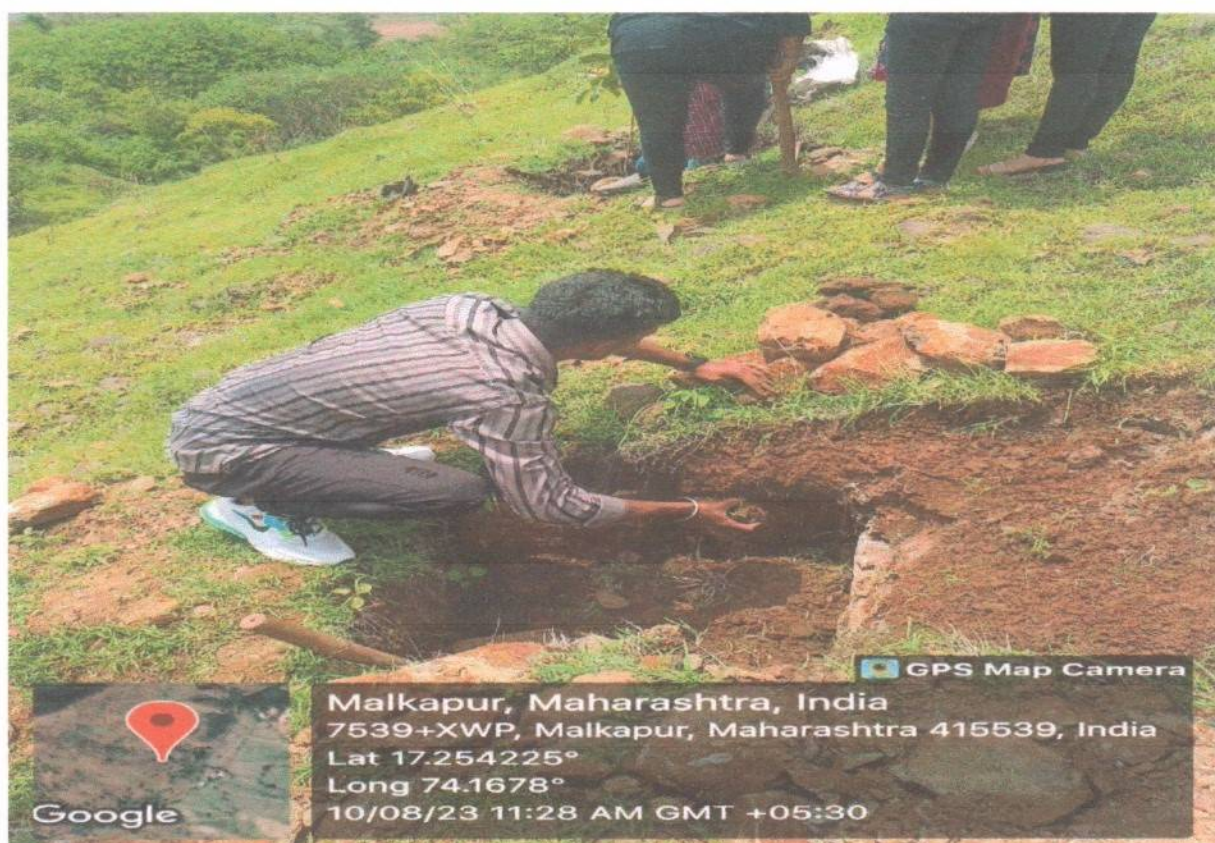

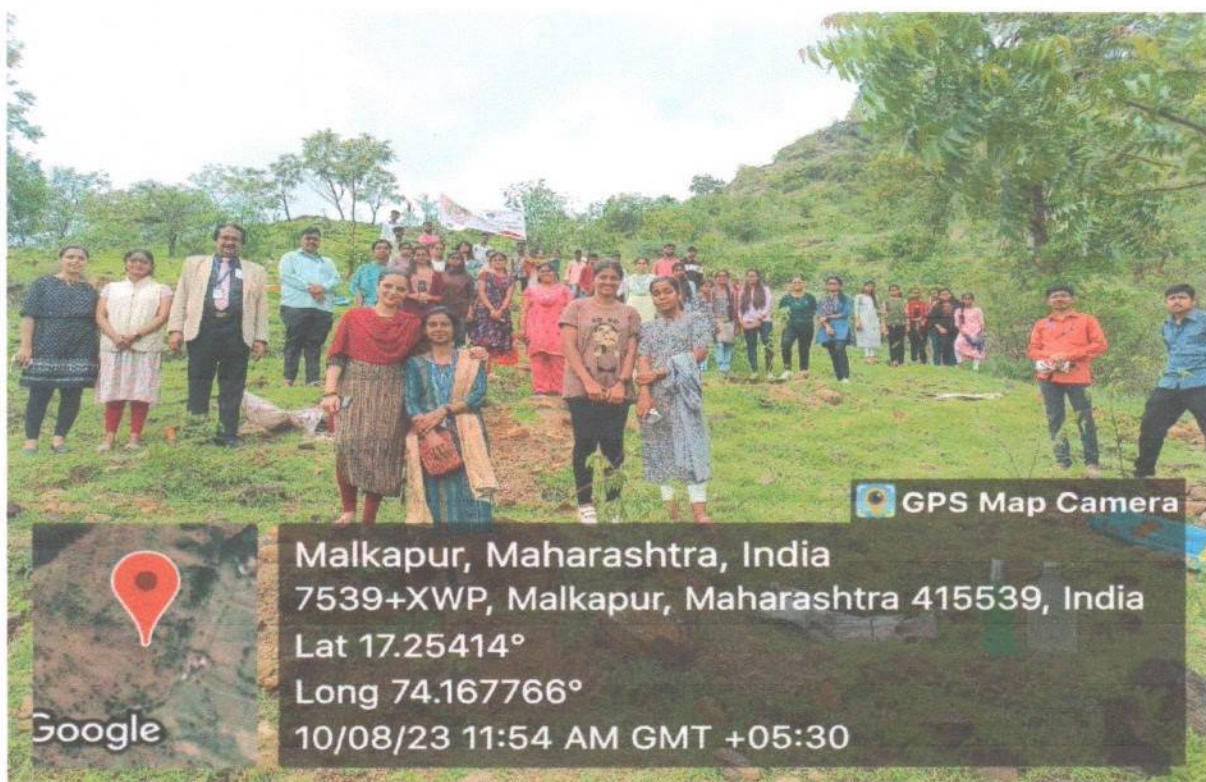

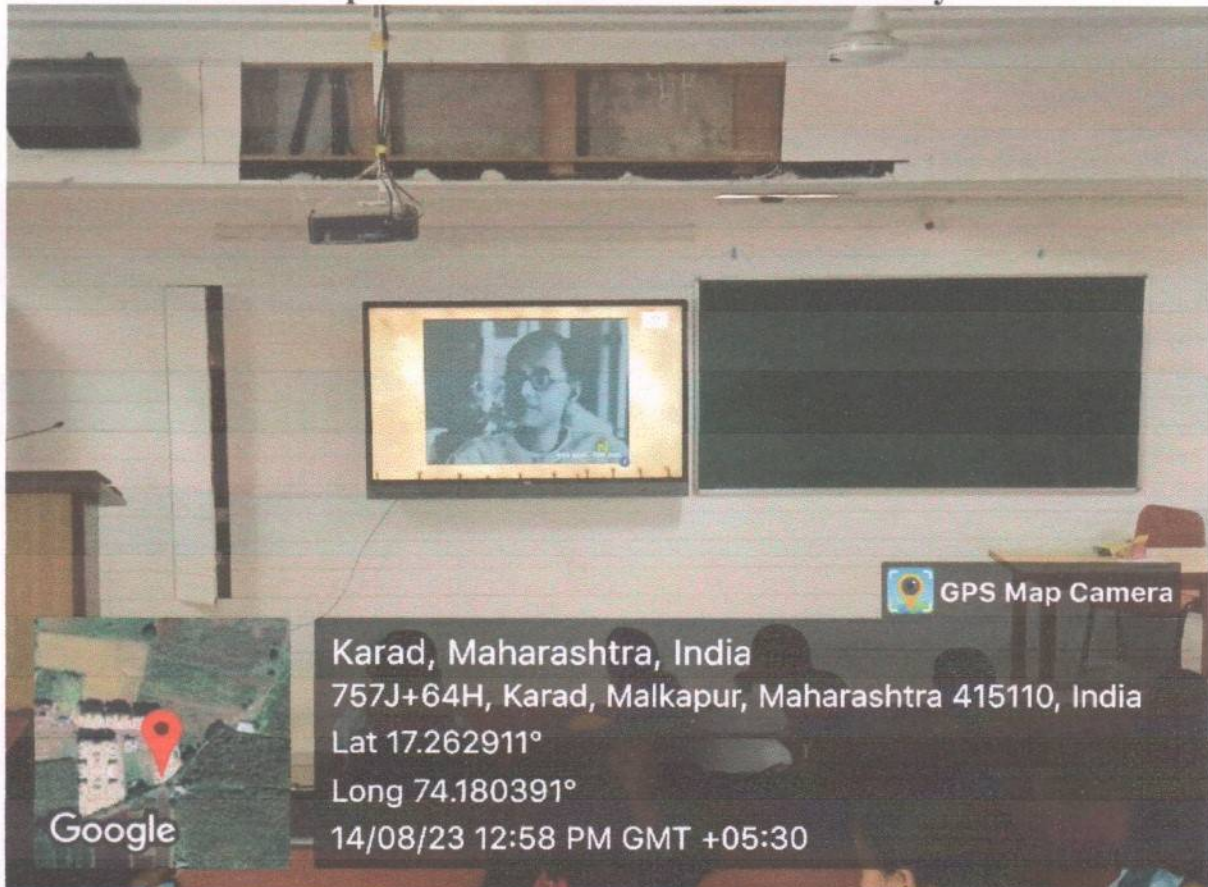

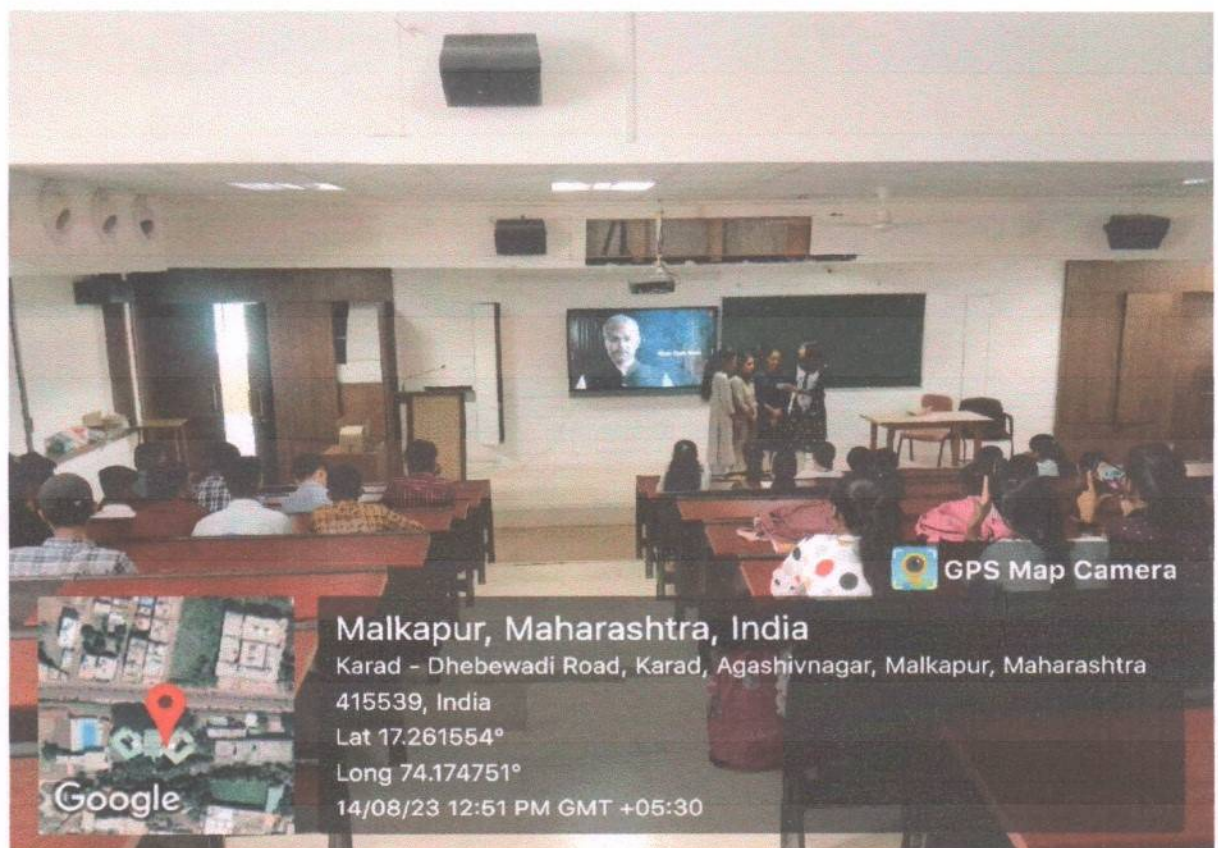

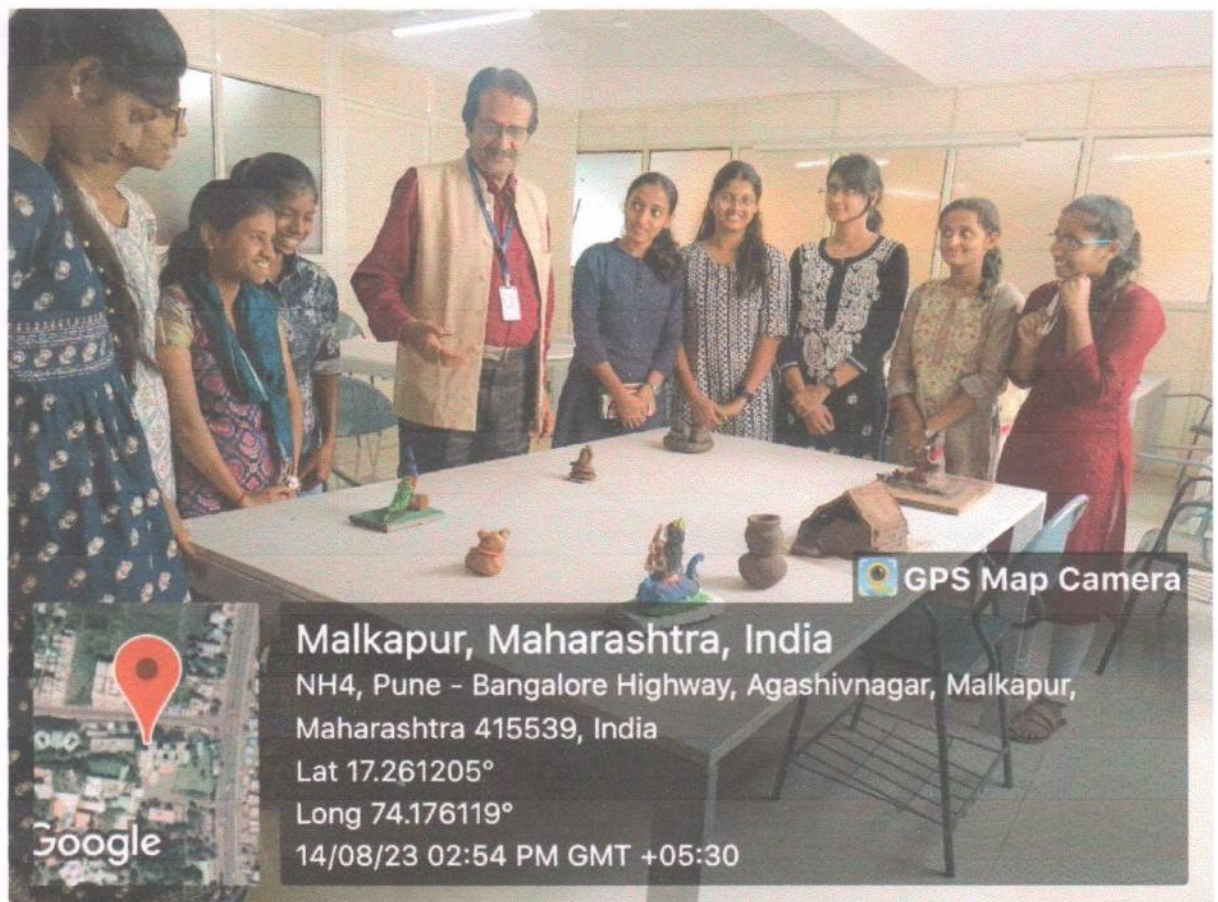

Summary of activity:

Teachers' Day in India is celebrated on 5th September to commemorate the birth anniversary of Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan. He was a renowned scholar, recipient of Bharat Ratna, first Vice-President, and second President of independent India. He was born on 5th September 1888. As an educationist, he was an advocate of edification and was a distinguished envoy, academician, and above all a great teacher.

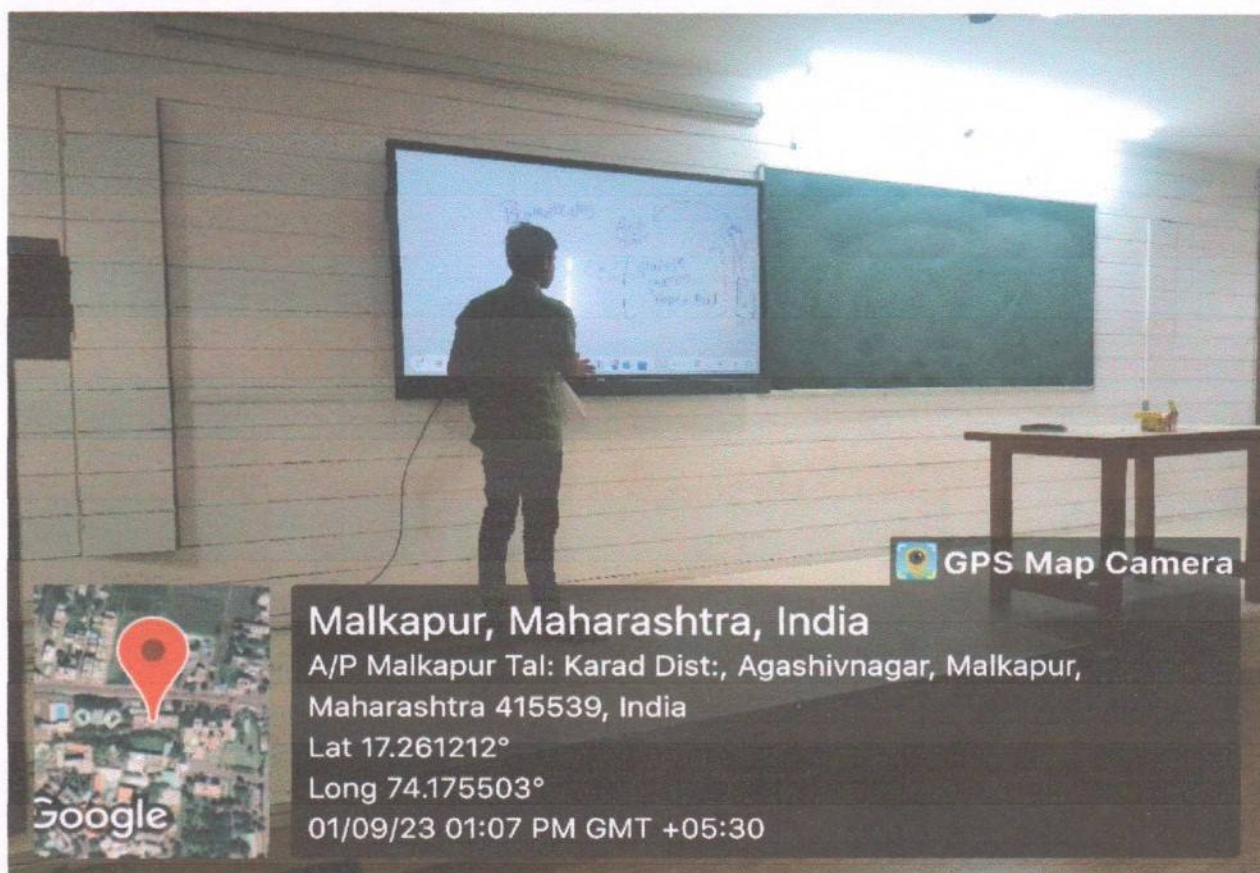

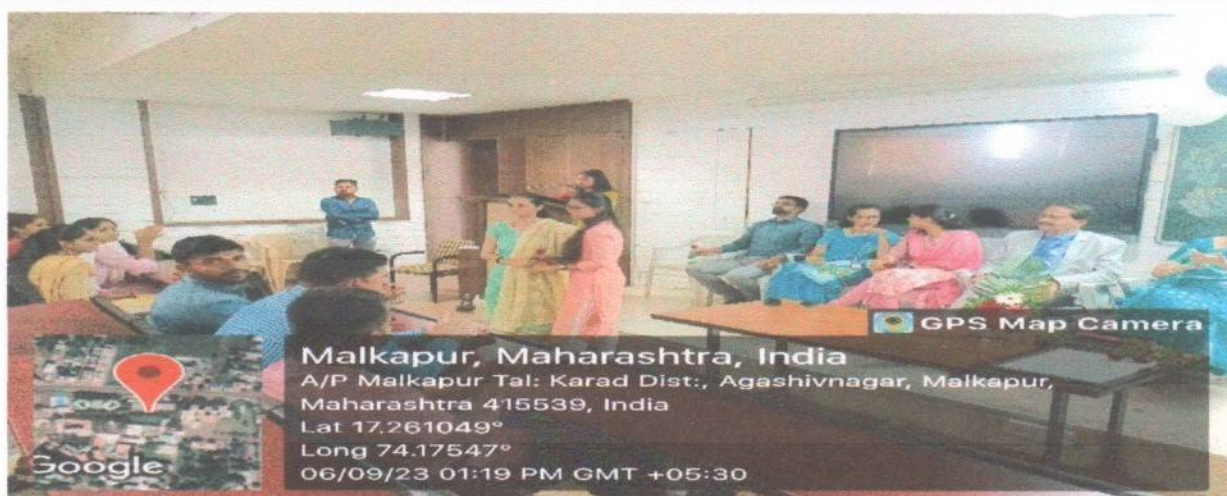
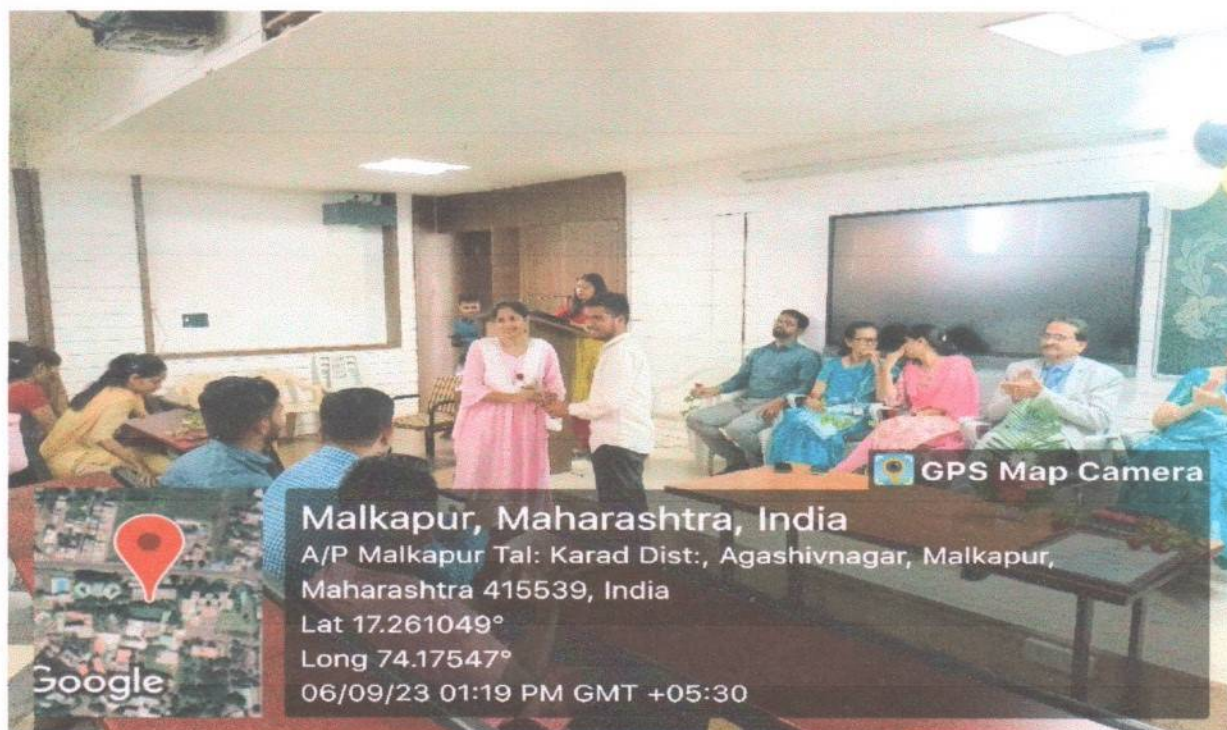
B) Celebration for teachers:

All the students from undergraduates and postgraduates were participated in Annual sports.

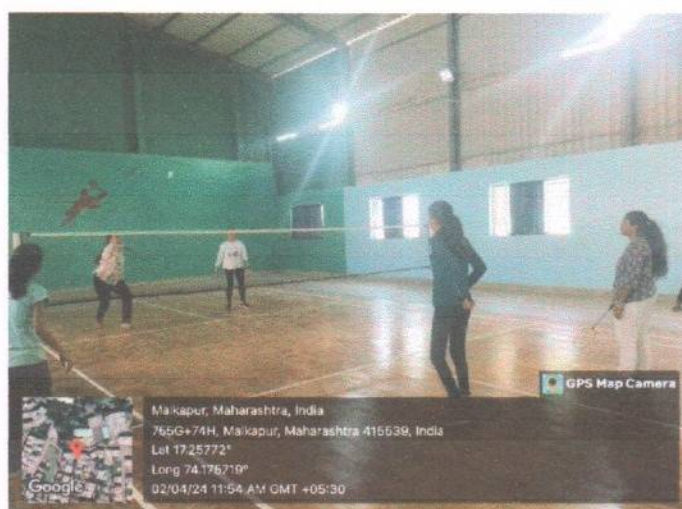
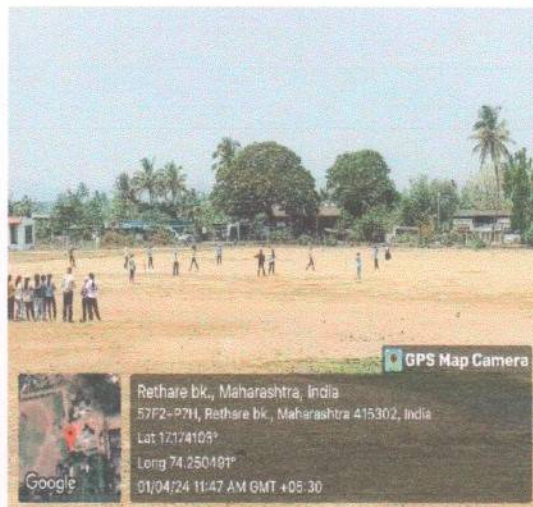
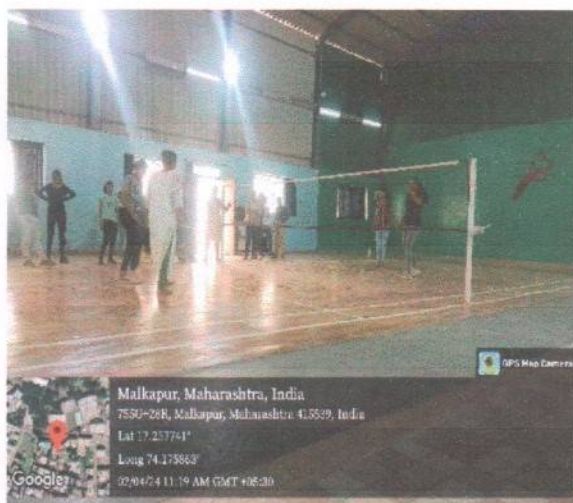
