Job Description:

Krishna Vishwa Vidyapeeth, formerly known as KIMSDU, is currently seeking a dedicated and competent Blood Transfusion Officer (BTO) to join its Blood Centre. The ideal candidate should possess sound knowledge of transfusion medicine, blood component preparation, donor management, quality systems and regulatory requirements. The candidate will be responsible for ensuring safe and efficient blood transfusion services in compliance with statutory and quality standards.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Supervise and manage the day-to-day operations of the Blood Centre, ensuring compliance with Drugs and Cosmetics Act, NACO, NABH, NABL and other applicable regulatory requirements.
- Oversee donor selection, medical examination, donor counselling, donor eligibility assessment and management of donor-related activities.
- Ensure safe collection, processing, testing, storage, quality control and issue of blood and blood components as per established standards.
- Monitor blood grouping, cross-matching, compatibility testing, transfusion-related investigations, management of transfusion reactions and adverse donor reactions.



- Plan, organize, coordinate and supervise voluntary blood donation camps, donor awareness programmes, donor recruitment and donor retention initiatives.
- Maintain quality management systems, SOPs, statutory records, reports, documentation and participate in audits, inspections, accreditation assessments and licensing activities.
- Monitor blood inventory, ensure availability of blood and blood components, and oversee maintenance, calibration, and validation of Blood Centre equipment.
- Provide training and guidance to Blood Centre staff, participate in Hospital Transfusion Committee activities, promote rational use of blood components, and perform other duties assigned by the Competent Authority.

The candidate will be responsible for ensuring uninterrupted availability of clean linen across all hospital areas while maintaining quality, hygiene and operational efficiency.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Supervise and manage the day-to-day operations of the Linen and Laundry Department, ensuring uninterrupted linen supply to all hospital areas.
- Ensure proper collection, segregation, washing, drying, ironing, folding, storage, and distribution of linen in accordance with infection control and hospital protocols.
- Monitor linen inventory, conduct periodic stock verification, and maintain optimum linen par levels across wards, ICUs, OTs, hostels, and other user departments.



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- Coordinate with Nursing, Housekeeping, CSSD, Hostel, and other departments to ensure timely availability and replacement of linen.
- Ensure compliance with NABH, infection control guidelines, biomedical waste management practices and other applicable quality standards.
