Essentiality Certificate

This is to certify that there is presently a need to start new Dental College in the State of Maharashtra. At present there are 22 Dental Colleges and have 1640 admission seats in all Dental Colleges in the State of Maharashtra. The total number of registered dentists are 10745 and the ratio of the Dentist to the Population of Maharashtra is 1:8573. At present there are only 6 Dental Colleges having only 440 admission capacity in Pune Division. Hence, it is desirable to grant permission to start a new Dental College at Karad with annual intake capacity of 100 students by Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences, Karad, (Deemed University) Dist. Satara in Maharashtra in the said Division area.

- 2. The certificate is being given on the Condition that the college will fulfill the norms and conditions laid down by Dental Council of India, New Delhi and will not employ/ engage any teacher from the Government Dental Colleges except their retirement and superannuation.
- This Certificate is issued subject to condition that the permission of University of Grant Commission, New Delhi and the Permission of Human Resources Department, Government of India, New Delhi for affiliating the said college to Deemed University. The validity of said Certificate is valid upto 31st December, 2008
- 4. It is also certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the Dental College as per Dental Council of India's norms and fresh admissions are stopped by Dental Council of India, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the college with the permission of Central Government.
