1	631566	16/F	Laser procedure for exposure of the impacted maxillary left 2 nd molar followed by traction mechanics applied	Under local anaesthesia, the impacted maxillary second molar was exposed using a diode soft-tissue laser. The overlying soft tissue was ablated incrementally, with saline irrigation used to prevent charring. Once adequate buccal surface exposure was achieved, orthodontic bonding was performed. The tooth was etched with 37% phosphoric acid, followed by application of a fourth-generation bonding agent and light curing for 10 seconds. A button chain attachment was bonded usingOrmco composite and cured for 30 seconds. Orthodontic traction was then initiated using simple tandem mechanics to facilitate eruption of the impacted molar.
2	631341	15/F	Fixed functional appliance therapy using Power scope therapy	Patient Presented With skeletal class II malocclusion with class II molar and Class II canine relation with overjet of 12mm, overbite of 90% Hence This appliance was given to correct the malocclusion

3	624958	14/F	Removal of Periapical condensing osteitis in region 42 and 43	Full thickness mucoperiosteal flap raised in 42 , 43 region followed by osseous resection of bone in 42 – 43 region using carbide bur under continuous irrigation followed by suturing done with same
4	670637	20/M	Upper 0.018 ss placed in upper arch	Patient has class III malocclusion so the plan decided is to relieve the crowding and class III relation
5	634790	12/F	Fixed functional appliance therapy using advansync therapy	Patient has skeletal class II malocclusion with class II molar and canine relation with overjet of 10mm, overbite of 80% so appliance was given to correct the malocclusion
