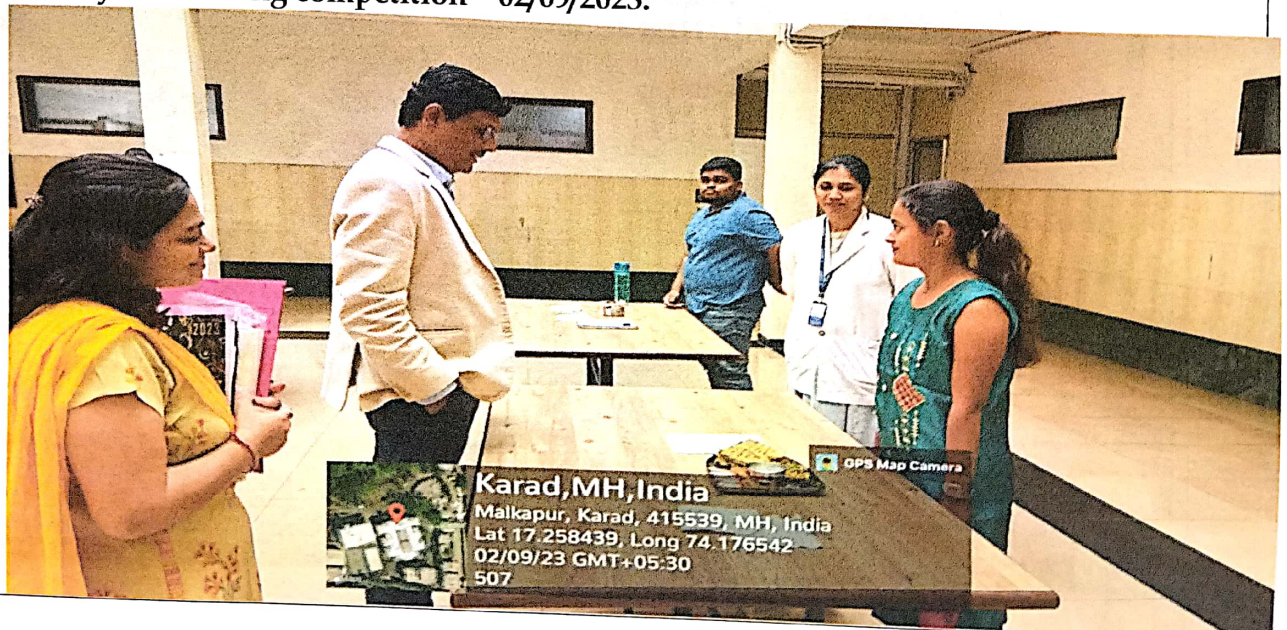

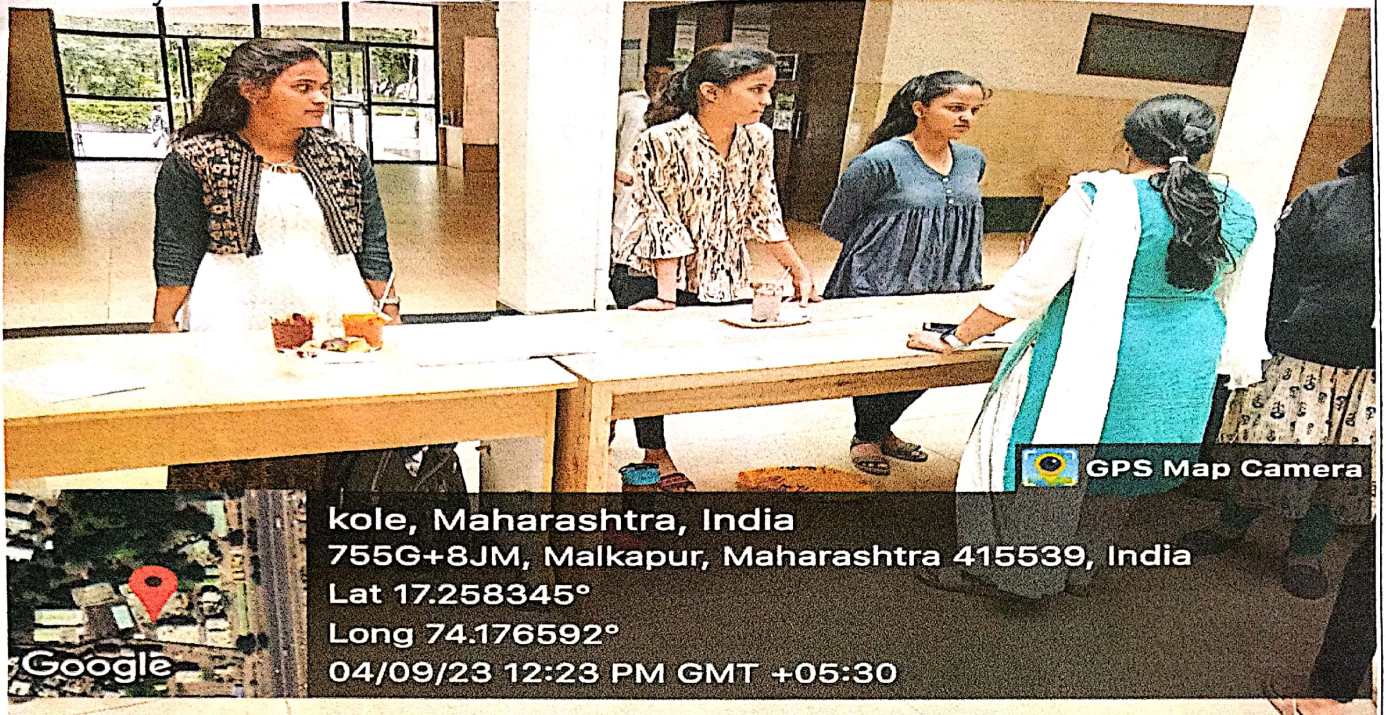

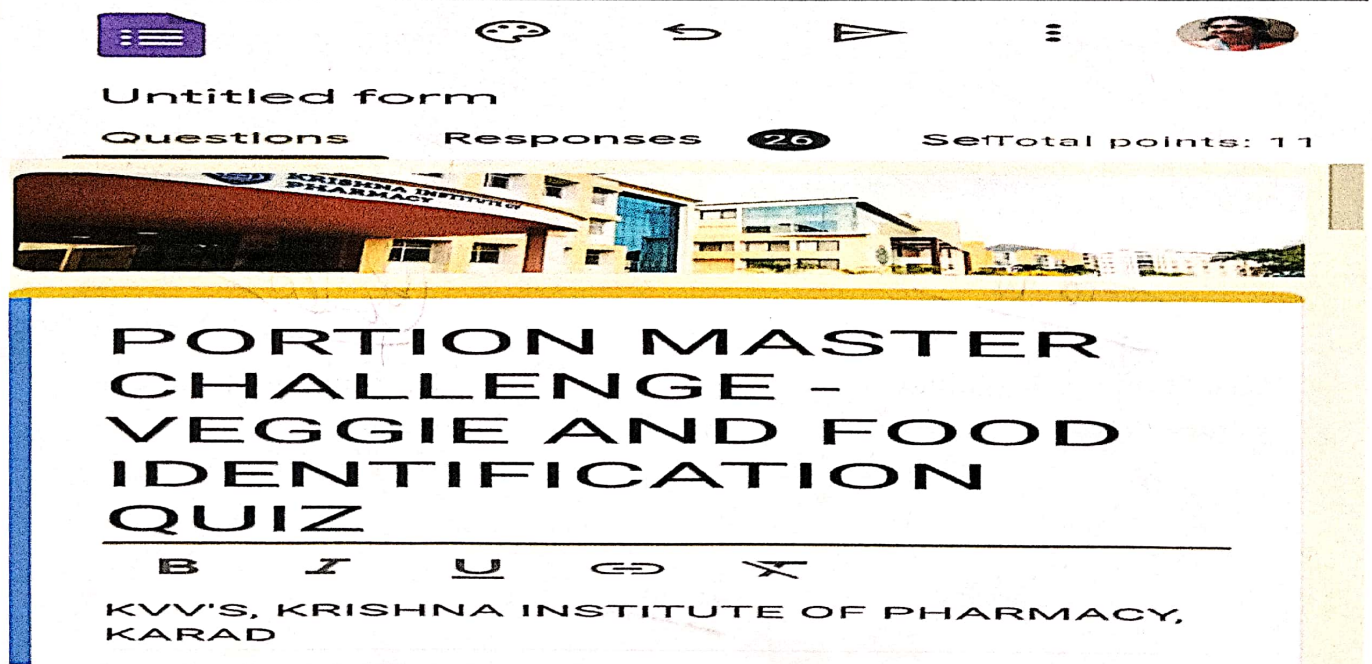


Image no 8 - Image of Google form for quiz.

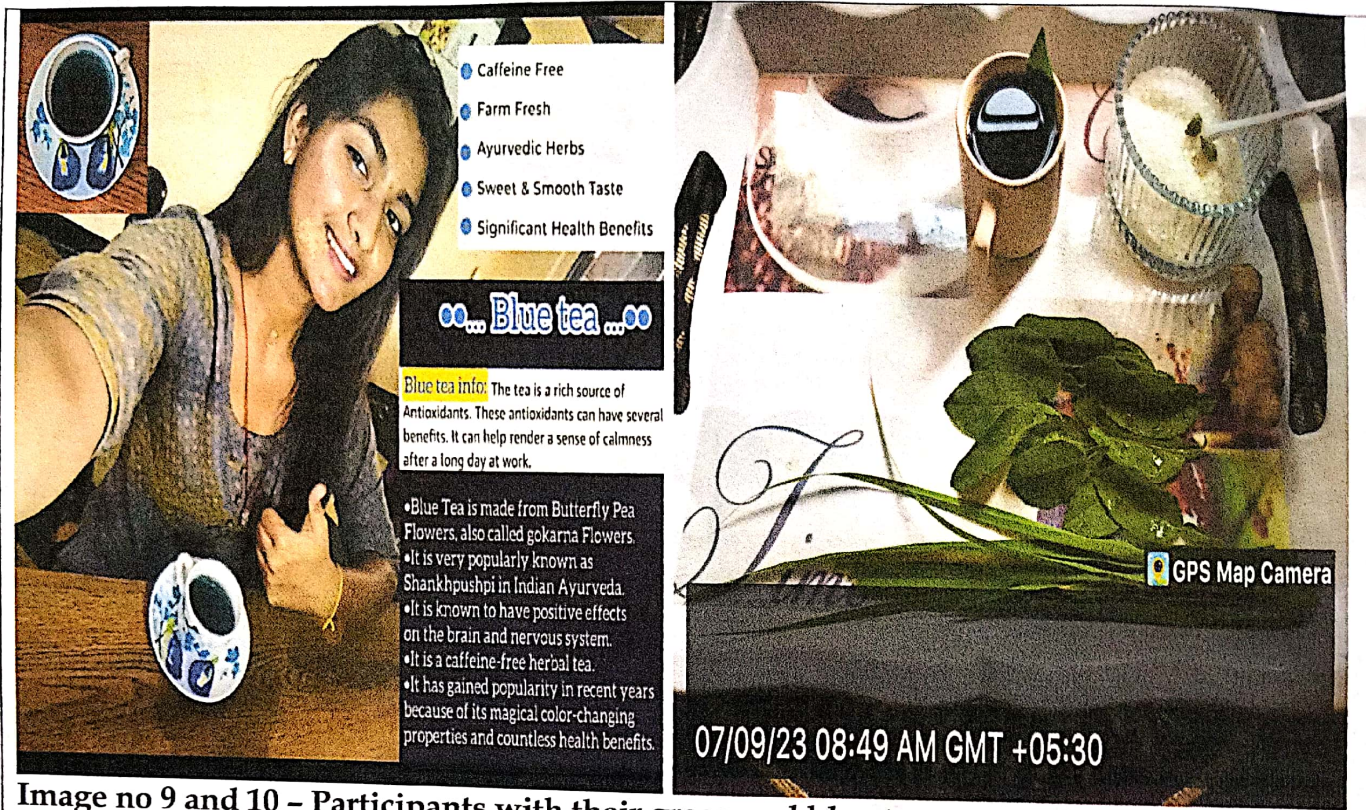

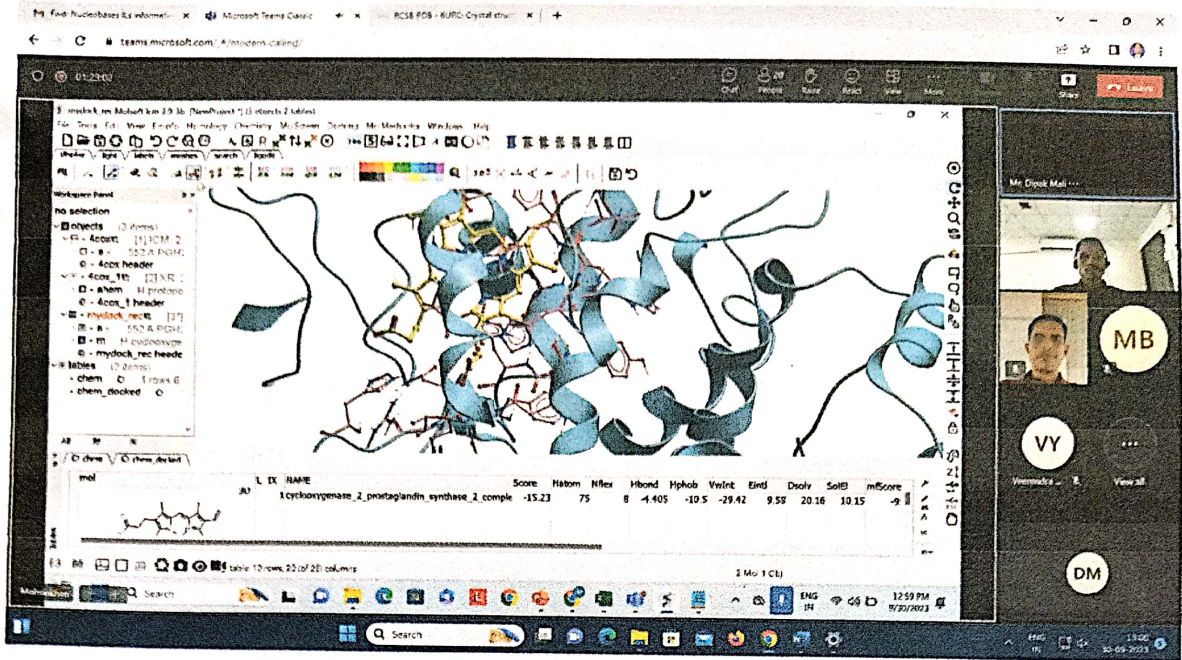

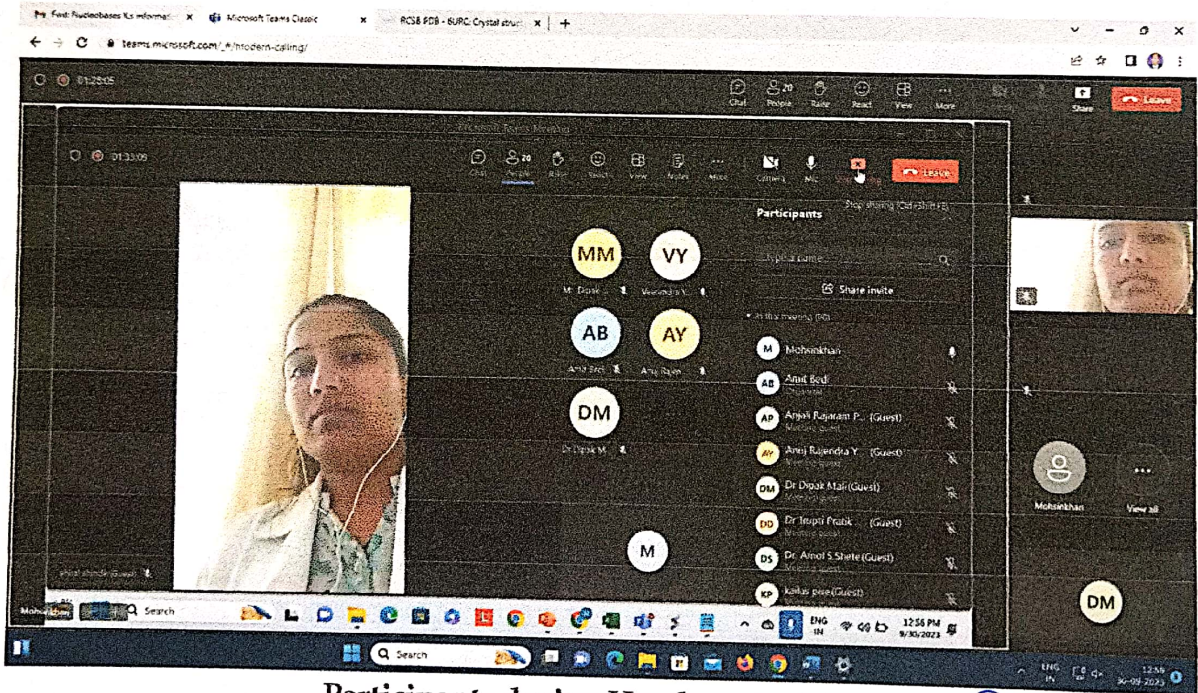

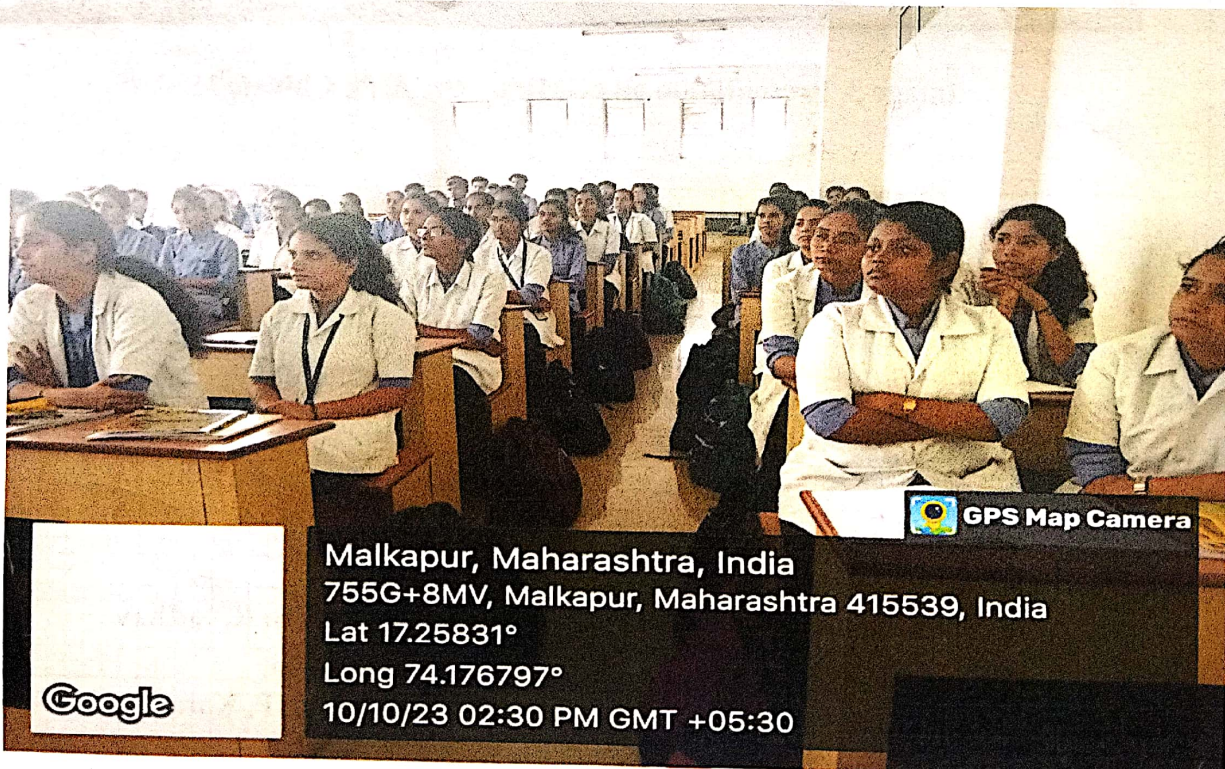


Image 2. One-hour sensitization activity on cGMP.

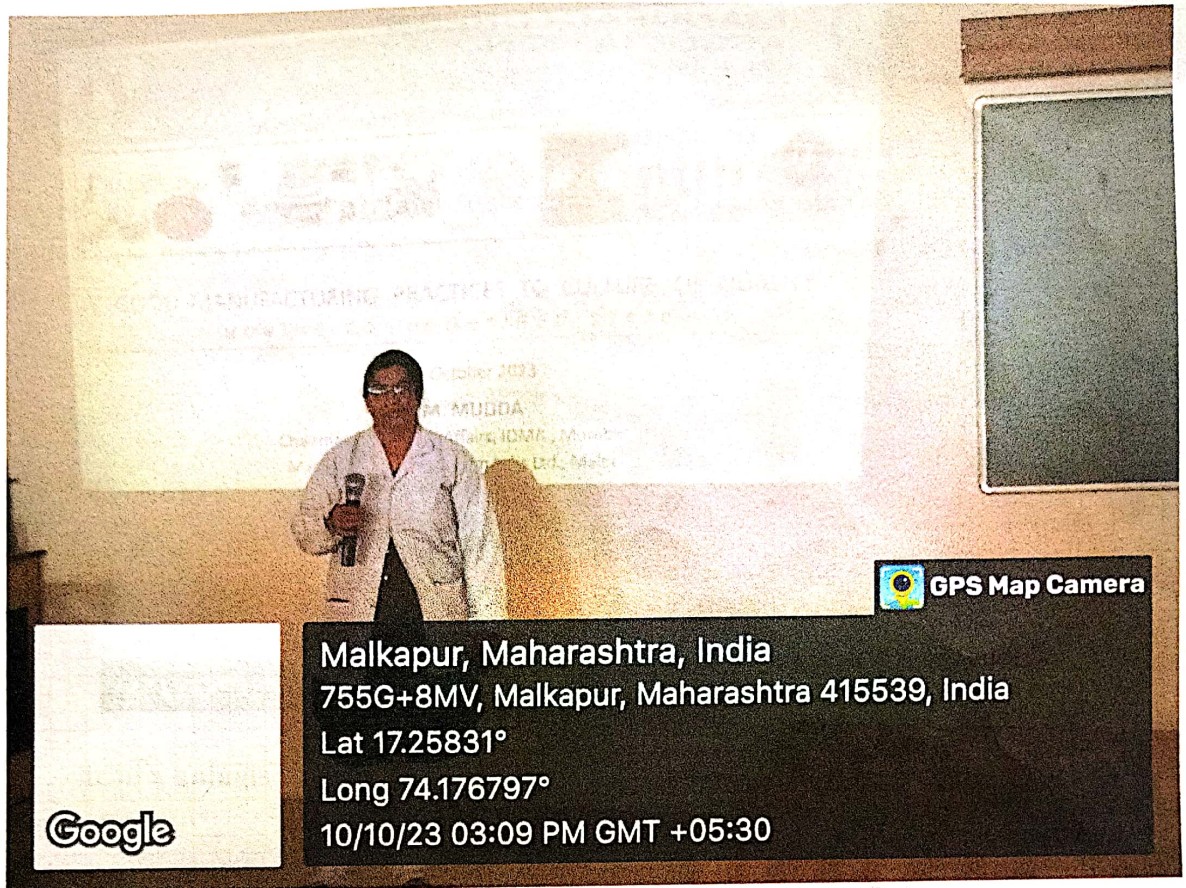
